

The exhibition will be on view for two weeks only, through March 12th. A portion of proceeds will be donated to the not-for-profit arts organization, Prospect Art. Gallery hours are Thursdays - Saturdays, 11:00 AM - 5:00 PM, or by appointment. Proof of COVID-19 vaccination will be required to enter the gallery and masks must be worn while inside the gallery.

Each year, Open Mind Art Space maintains a tradition of hosting an Annual Anniversary Exhibition to honor its artists who contributed to the gallery's programming from 2016 to the present. For its 6th Annual Anniversary Exhibition, popular and new works by Open Mind artists will be featured, and works by newly selected artists will be introduced. The exhibition will feature original paintings, drawings, and mixed media works. Artworks will range in size up to 24 inches, and vary in price from \$500 and less. Small art prints and objects will also be available, and Open Mind Art Space will be donating 10% of proceeds to Prospect Art.

Open Mind Art Space looks forward to continuing to showcase contemporary art from a diverse blend of talented emerging artists, and facilitating a curatorial process that allows its artists to create impactful work, while furthering its mission to inspire and challenge the local Los Angeles community by providing a comfortable, engaging space for reflection and dialogue. Open Mind also believes that art can be a powerful way to motivate positive change in people and the world as a whole. To show its support for non-profit organizations that reflect its values, Open Mind has chosen to benefit a new local not-for-profit arts organization recently co-founded by Open Mind artist Gioj De Marco called Prospect Art, for this year's anniversary exhibition.

Prospect Art is a forward-thinking, Los Angeles-based artist-run not-for-profit 501c3 organization that fosters artists' careers by providing exposure through open dialogues, critical writing, project grants, and exhibitions. Prospect Art is looking towards a world of representation and equality by creating new opportunities for local, national, and international artists, and is interested in breaking down silos and sharing information and knowledge to further the careers of artists and forge new alliances with the community. The organization is structured as an agile, responsive entity to serve artists, the local Los Angeles community, and beyond, by supporting existing and new works to be presented to the public.
